

## George Ross and Skin Lesions

# Lesions Removal Fact Sheet

## What benign lesions are treated

telangiectasia / capillaries	milia	xanthelasma	cholesterol deposits	spots

## Method & results

**METHOD:** Your skin lesion will be removed with a unique combination of radio frequency and high frequency. The instrument effectively treats a wide range of common minor skin irregularities. **If you are suspicious about any skin lesion contact your doctor immediately!**

**HOW MANY SESSIONS:** Treatments are very quick, with **instantaneous results, minor discomfort and no skin penetration**. 1 session is enough in most cases. However, the 2nd & sometimes the 3rd session may be needed for some lesions. **Full charge is applied for each treatment**. If your lesion does not respond the second time, you are discouraged re-treating it - the lesion's root may be too deep or the lesion may simply be resistant to treatment. Although this is rare, it happens. Our method is effective with only 1-3% of lesions needing a repeat session

**AGE LIMIT:** Patients under 18 must have a parent/guardian present for consultation/to sign forms. Min age for this service is 17yo

## Before the procedure

**WHY YOU NEED A CLEARANCE LETTER:** Our skin lesions removal is a cosmetic procedure with high success rate. We can remove most visible lesions. Since removal of a suspicious lesion can delay diagnosis or even turn a cancerous lesion into a more aggressive one, you must first check your lesions with a doctor. Once lesions have been cleared and identified as benign we will gladly treat them

**IMPORTANT:** **Treatment is only possible with a doctor's consent**. Each consent/clearance letter is valid for 6 months from the date of the letter. There are no exceptions to these rules except for skin tags, xanthelasma/cholesterol deposits

**YOUR OVERALL HEALTH:** Your GP has your complete **medical history**, including information about other health problems, past health problems, current medications, occupation as well as any health issues that run in the family. Whilst at times some information may not appear relevant, it is very helpful to your doctor to formulate a diagnosis and identify any skin cancers/suspicious spots that you may not have noticed elsewhere on the body

**NEED A DOCTOR?** If you do not have a regular physician, we are able to provide you with a list of suitable physicians. **We can also organise for you to see a physician in the medical centre near our clinic**. We make no representations and although we assist you it is **our strong preference that you see your regular GP**.

## Safety & Side Effects

When it comes to the human body there is not too much that you can predict with 100 per cent certainty

**HYPERPIGMENTATION & SCARS:** You must be aware there is a small **chance of scarring/hyperpigmentation** in the area of the mole and you must be prepared for this.

**LIGHT SKIN PATIENTS:** If a temporary mark is left post treatment, it would be the same or smaller diameter as the lesion. So far there has been no record of permanent scarring with any of our patients

**DARKER SKIN PATIENTS:** These skins are very prone to hyperpigmentation. These patients need to expect pigment changes in the treated area (usually not extending past the diameter of the lesion removed). With appropriate care pigmentation is minimised or completely resolved within 3 skin cellular renewal cycles (each cycle is 28days in healthy skin).

**HEALING:** It may take anywhere between 4 & 12wks for the healing process to be completed. We offer a number of ways to help skin **heal faster and more efficiently**. As with all healing processes a lot depends on your overall state of wellness & health of your skin

**IMPORTANT NOTE:**

**If a possibility of a left over scar/mark/ pigmentation scares you please do not proceed with the treatment**

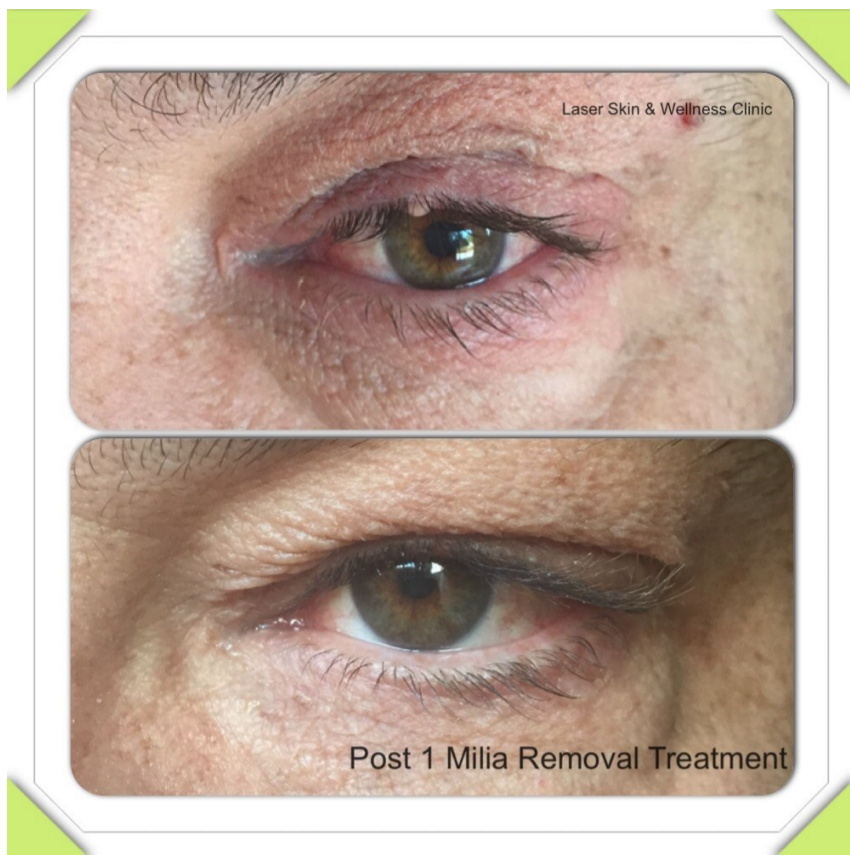

# Lesions Removal Examples



## Process of REMOVAL

Unwanted skin lesions are removed with a **unique combination** of radio and high frequencies which **rapidly denatures protein** in the lesion causing it to dry up.

A wide range of common minor skin irregularities are **effectively treated without penetrating the skin**. Most lesions require just 1 treatment. Some lesions may need up to 3.

## Skin tags

Skin tags are very common small, **harmless (but annoying) soft skin growths**. A person may have anywhere from one to hundreds of skin tags. Skin tags usually respond to treatments very well with majority only needing one session.

**Most harmless but unsightly and annoying irregularities are treated quickly & effectively!**

## Xanthelasma, Corneal Arcus or Cholesterol Deposits

*Xanthelasma and corneal arcus* usually occur on the eye or eyelids. Although these are **considered to be signs of elevated blood cholesterol** it is not always the case.

*Cholesterol deposits* are just unsightly **bumps of fat** that tend to develop underneath your skin, usually in the inner canthus of the upper eyelid.



## Xanthoma

If you notice cosmetically disfiguring fatty deposits form beneath the skin, it might be a good idea to check them out. *Xanthomas* may appear anywhere on the body, but are most frequently found on the elbows, joints, tendons, knees, hands, feet, and buttocks. They range from very small to up to 3 inches in size.

## Milia

**Small, hard, white bumps** that can show up—mostly on the face—in just about anyone, including infants, teens, and adults. These **frustrating yet benign bumps** are **incredibly stubborn, lasting for weeks, months, and sometimes longer!** Most of the time they respond within 2-3 sessions with long lasting results.

## Fibromas

*Fibromas (or fibroid tumors or fibroids)* are **benign tumours** that are composed of fibrous or connective tissue. They can grow in all organs, arising from mesenchyme tissue.

The term "fibroblastic" or "fibromatous" is used to describe the fibrous connective tissue.

When the term *fibroma* is used without modifier, it is usually considered benign, with the term fibrosarcoma reserved or malignant tumour.

These may need several sessions
