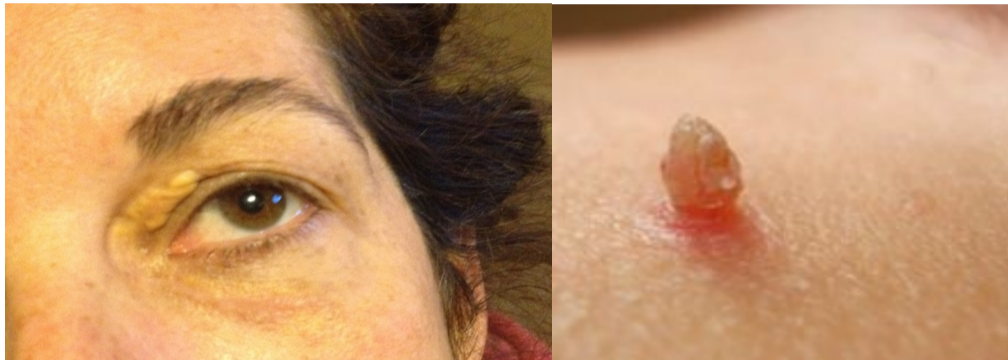


SKIN LESIONS - fact sheet 1

PROCESS of removal

Your unwanted skin lesion will be removed with a unique combination of radio & high frequencies which rapidly denatures protein in the lesion causing it to dry up. **If you are suspicious about any skin lesion contact your doctor immediately!**



How many sessions are needed

Treatments are very quick, with **instantaneous results, minor discomfort and no skin penetration.**

1 session is enough in most cases. However, the 2nd & sometimes the 3rd session may be needed for some lesions.

Full charge is applied for each treatment. If your lesion does not respond the second time, you are discouraged re-treating it - the lesion's root may be too deep or the lesion may simply be resistant to treatment. We will not treat any lesion more than 3 times. Although this is rare, it happens. Our method is effective with only 1-3% of lesions needing a repeat session

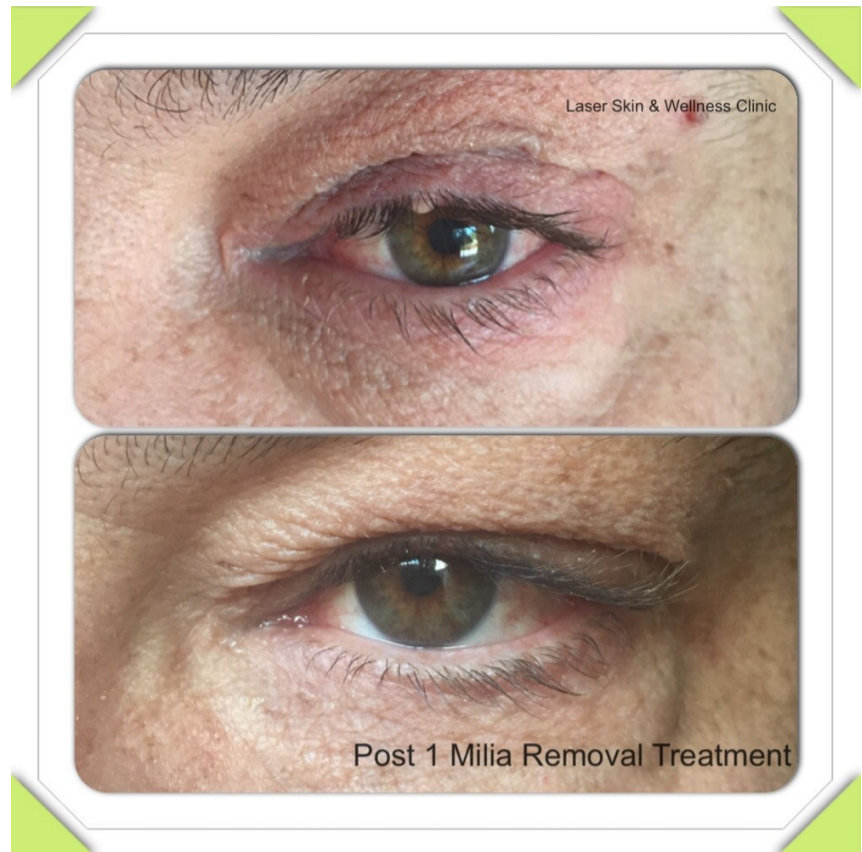
NOTE: Patients under 18 must have a parent/guardian present for consult & treatment. Min age for this service is 17yo.

What lesions can be treated

Skin tags

Skin tags are common small, harmless but annoying soft skin growths. You may have anywhere from 1 to 100s of skin tags. They respond to treatment very well with majority only needing 1 session.



Milia

Small, hard, white bumps can show up (mostly on face) - in just about anyone, including infants, teens & adults. **Frustrating yet benign bumps are incredibly stubborn** & can come back in weeks or months. Most respond immediately. Maintenance sessions usually needed every 6-18mths

Fibromas

Fibromas are **benign tumours** that are composed of fibrous or connective tissue. They can grow in all organs, arising from mesenchyme tissue. The term "fibroblastic" or "fibromatous" is used to describe the fibrous connective tissue. These need several sessions

Xanthoma

These cosmetically disfiguring fatty deposits form beneath the skin & it's a good idea to check them out. It may appear anywhere on the body, but most frequently found on elbows, joints, tendons, knees, hands, feet, buttocks. Could be up to 3 inches in size.

Xanthelasma/Cholesterol d.

Xanthelasma/ cholesterol deposits and corneal arcus usually occur on the eye or eyelids. Although these are **considered to be signs of elevated blood cholesterol it is not always the case.** Very responsive to treatment but may return after a while.

Before the procedure

WHY YOU NEED A CLEARANCE LETTER: Our skin lesions removal is a cosmetic procedure with high success rate. We can remove most visible lesions. Since removal of a suspicious lesion can delay diagnosis or even turn a cancerous lesion into a more aggressive one, you must first check your lesions with a doctor. Once lesions have been cleared & identified as benign we will gladly treat them

IMPORTANT: Treatment is only possible with a doctor's consent. Each consent/clearance letter is valid for 6 months from the date of the letter. There are no exceptions to these rules except for skin tags, xanthelasma/cholesterol deposits, milia

YOUR OVERALL HEALTH: Your GP has your complete **medical history**, including information about past/present health issues, medications as any health related issue that run in the family. Whilst at times some information may not appear relevant, it is very helpful to your doctor to formulate a diagnosis and identify any skin cancers/suspicious spots that you may not have noticed elsewhere on the body

NEED A DOCTOR? If you do not have a regular GP, we are able to provide you with a list of physicians who have recently cleared lesions for our patients or who have referred us their patients. **We no longer have a doctor on site to perform checks.**

Investment

1 LESION:	\$89 (\$69 current special)

Treatment NOT CLAIMABLE via Medicare/Health Insur

After the procedure

No dressing is required. Medicated Antiseptic powder is applied. You must keep treated area dry with the powder for 3-7days. Lesion will scab. Scabs take 1-2wks to naturally fall off. You may have some discoloration in the area (pinkness) & that can take 4-10wks to go away. Medicated antiseptic powder and healing accelerating serum available at the clinic.

NOTE: healing time varies depending on your overall health

AFTER SERVICE: At the end of the procedure you will get a text message with written and video aftercare instructions

10 Home care tips

- 1) Post treatment, area may feel irritated/ tender/ red
- 2) Keep area dry with medicated powder
- 3) No hot showers - 48 hours
- 4) No swimming (pool/ocean) - 2 weeks
- 5) Pat dry, don't rub as it may remove scab prematurely
- 6) Do not expose area to sun 11am-5pm
- 7) No peeling/ bleaching products—4 weeks
- 8) Use only mild products in shower with no alcohol
- 9) Come back for complimentary review 8 weeks later
- 10) Temporary scabbing may form. Do not pick at the scabs, allow them to fall off naturally . Prematurely removed scabs cause hyperpigmentation and/or scars

Side effects

When it comes to the human body there is not much that you can predict with 100 per cent certainty—If a possibility of a left over scar/mark/ pigmentation scares you please **DO NOT PROCEED** with this treatment!!!

HYPERPIGMENTATION: there is a small chance of discoloration in treated area and you must be prepared for this

MARKS & SCARS: temporary marks are usually smaller in diameter than treated lesion. Marks may be permanent

DARKER SKIN PATIENTS: Due to nature of this skin expect pigment change in treated area (usually not extending past the diameter of the lesion removed). With appropriate care it's minimised/fully resolved in 3-4 skin cellular renewal cycles (each cycle= 28days)

HEALING: Depending on your health, it may take up to 12wks for the healing process to be completed. Ask for ways to help skin heal faster and more efficiently
